Q. What type of apron would you recommend I buy for my child for use in the kitchen and for craft lessons at school?

A. We always recommend that you invest in some heavy-duty PVC, wipe-clean flame-retardant aprons for use in the kitchen and at school, ensuring that they are wiped with hot, soapy water after each use. They are easy maintenance, durable, protect against flame and repel water.

Q. Are plastic disposable aprons alright to wear in the kitchen?

A. No. They are very thin and easily melt on contact with heat and are so flimsy that a draught can blow them upwards and catch them on equipment.

Q. What advice would you give to teachers thinking of buying aprons for their school?

A. Always ensure to follow the advice of your Education Authority's safety policy when buying aprons for your school. It is imperative you know the composition of the fabric to ensure you purchase only those aprons approved by your education authority.

Q. Does the size and fit of apron really matter?

A. Yes. We strongly recommend that you avoid wearing loose-fitting aprons to prevent clothing from becoming easily exposed to stains and catching in dangerous equipment.

Q. How should I wash my cloth aprons?

A. Ensure to hot wash your cloth aprons and dry thoroughly after each use.
